

BY LAWS FOR CITY OF LEEDS SYNCHRONISED SWIMMING CLUB

The word "team" shall mean all swimmers representing the Club at competition, be it as a solo duet or team.

Support staff shall mean all coaches, team managers, chaperones and anybody involved with the team organisation, but not parents.

1. Swimming members must remain in membership of a feeder club
 - a. Swimmers resigning from a feeder club must inform the secretary as soon as practicable
 - b. Should the secretary not be informed of the new feeder club within two full calendar months then the swimmer will be deemed as resigning from the City of Leeds Synchronised Swimming Club
 - c. The committee has the power to suspend the swimmer from training with the City of Leeds during the period between resigning from one feeder club and joining another
 - d. Any swimmer found to have resigned from a feeder club and not informed the secretary of the resignation shall be suspended from training and the committee will have the power to expel the swimmer
2. All Swimmer ASA Fees paid through feeder club
3. Swimming members shall be first claim at all national events and above
4. Any swimming member who is not chosen for the C.O.L. team will be released from by-law 3
5. The coach shall inform prospective team members a minimum of one clear session prior to intensive training
 - a. Information will be confirmed in writing and
 - i. Be given to the swimmer at training
or
 - ii. Sent by e-mail
or
 - iii. Both
6. Swimmers selected for the team shall inform the coach that they do not wish to be part of the team before intensive training starts
7. Subject to By-law 6, Swimmers selected to represent the club and not compete; including training during run up to competition, without good reason, they may be suspended from training
8. At competitions; swimmers and support staff shall wear club attire (*exceptions: support staff who are also officiating*)
9. At competitions all team members and support staff shall stay at the same hotel or inn. (*Exceptions may be staff who are also officiating at the competition*)
10. If the club hires transport for the team then it is preferable that all team members, and support staff will travel together. (*Exceptions may be staff who are also officiating at the competition*)
